Completed applications with essay and recommendation from supervisor of the volunteer/nonprofit organization you worked must be returned to the office for the Activities Director, Mr. Kidd, no later than Friday, May 17, 2019. *Note: It is the student's responsibility to retrieve and attach the supervisor's recommendation to the Art Washburn scholarship application.

Part I

The Deep Run High School Athletic Booster Club will award one \$1,000 scholarship to a senior who meets the following criteria:

1. The student's parent/guardian must be a current member of the Deep Run Athletic Booster Club.
2. The student must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
3. The student must be a 4 year athlete having participated in at least 1 sport (minimum) each year of their high school career.
4. The student must demonstrate a consistent passion of service through their commitment towards their chosen volunteer/nonprofit organization by dedication of their time, talents, effort and unselfish sacrifice to make a difference for others.
5. The student must complete a short essay about the volunteer organization and their work in it. (See Part II).
6. The student must obtain the recommendation from the supervisor of the organization they worked closely. (See Part III).
